





Step 1:

Discover Projects


- [1] Find a project of interest (or hearing about the damn thing!):
 - Join meetup groups
 - Talk to friends/colleagues
 - Browse github-help-wanted.com
- [2] Ask key questions:
 - Is the community friendly (welcoming)
 - Is the community friendly & welcoming?
 - Is the community fairly large?
 - Are there clear contributing instructions?
 - Is there a Code of Conduct?








Step 2: Get Involved

Read documentation.


Reach out to contributors.


